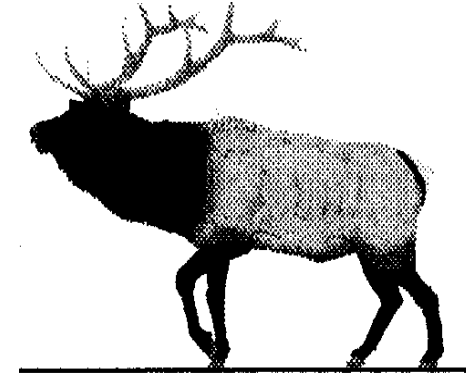

Participants can turn their jars into the Lodge Secretary or myself, whenever they wish. Please feel free to join the many, which are starting on their second and third jars.

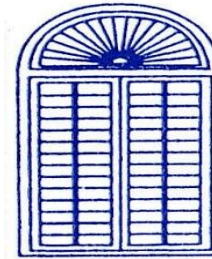
