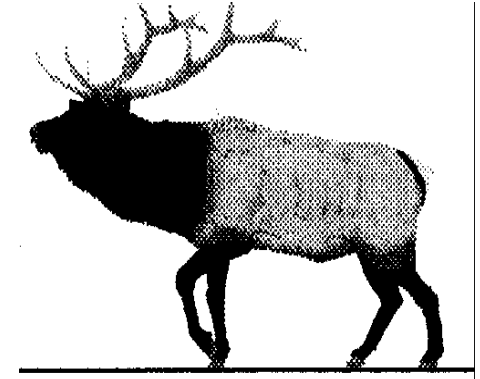

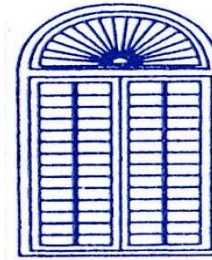
The program endeavors to help children in the county's after-school programs with exercise and nutritional information.
