Exalted Ruler's Message

As the year began, I was looking forward to all the great events we had planned for our Lodge. Then, March 13th hit and the Lodge had to close for nearly three months. Our Officer's Installation party was cancelled, Mid-Term, and Grand Lodge Conventions canceled, as well as most of the Lodge visitations to the district. We didn't open again until July 15 and only partially. In fact, we have never fully opened, with all our activities and events, since we closed in March. I would not blame you for feeling frustrated. We can all feel frustrated if we choose to. If we focus on the frustration, we will likely lose sight of our blessings.

In 2020, volunteers we hardly knew stepped up in ways we could not have imagined at the beginning of the year. When we reopened for the first time in July for the PER Fish Fry, we were elated that so many Elks showed up to our Lodge that day. The PER's donated their proceeds to the Lodge, we had raffles, volunteers played music, people who had never waitressed before took orders and we collected over 100 can goods and \$1000 to take to the Homeless Coalition.

Our Breast Cancer Survivor Party and Fundraiser chaired by Grace Andrews was also a big success. We raised \$1500 to donate to the Bailey Hospice Center through member donations, basket raffles and 50/50 raffle.

We began the year with a lot of maintenance items to resolve. Volunteers Randy Stay and Chris Love volunteered their time and replaced the kitchen ceiling. The flooring in our dining room and bar area was replaced, we painted the lodge room, hallway, pool room, bathroom and bar, we hired a new lawn company, cleaning company, and bug company, painted a new walkway outside of the pavilion, we repaired a water line (several times), replaced all the copper pipes in the entire building and the walls afterwards, replaced air conditioners, hot water heater, ice machine, freezer, replaced the lights in the walk in cooler with water proof lights, repaired the ice machine, added an emergency exit to the front porch with an alarm, replaced an outer door, repaired the lights on the sign out front, replaced the parking lights with LED's, repaired the alarm on the pool room outer door, cleaned and painted the cast iron grates on the stove, and cleaned the entire duct system in the lodge.

We began to make better use of the pavilion. Utilizing it for outdoor Lodge meetings, events like the Veterans Day Party (where we had volunteer's play music and gave free burgers, beer and desert and a commemorative coin to all our Veterans), lodge committee meetings, music and karaoke.

So, what were our blessings this year? Our number of delinquent members are smaller than they have ever been! My goal this year was to focus on Charity and we accomplished that by giving away over \$15,000 to charitable organizations! We gave over 5000 coloring books and ribbons for drug awareness to local schools, we gave 11 local scholarships out, the lodge was cleaned continuously to stop COVID from spreading.

Thank you to all the hearty souls that donated time, money, and sweat-equity during my term. You make a difference in our Lodge and community. I wish Joe and his team the best of luck next year! I've been honored and humbled to be your Exalted Ruler,
